

Shelton Tops Nation With Jump of 6-9 3-4

Southern California romped to its expectedly easy victory over UCLA at the Coliseum yesterday to maintain its record of never losing to the Bruins in a dual track meet and the Trojans scored a decision over the Bruin frosh in a mild upset.

Parry O'Brien's astounding shot-put performance overshadowed the collegiate competition but there were two varsity meet records set—one a best-in-the-world performance for 1954—and four yearling meet marks.

Final Scores

Southern California won the varsity meet, 95½ to 35½. The Trojans triumphed, 69½ to 61½.

Ernie Shelton, Trojan high-jump star, won at 6ft. 9¾in., breaking Johnny Wilson's 14-year-old meet record by ¾in. This is the highest official leap in the world this year.

Shelton barely touched the bar at his winning height which he cleared on the first try.

Then he assaulted 6ft. 10¾in. and on the second try appeared to be over. But as he lay in the pit the crosspiece came tumbling down on top of him. He also missed the third time.

Sparkling Races

The 880, mile and two-mile all produced the expected sparkling races.

Larry Carter, UCLA's captain, held off SC's Marty Montgomery in a thrilling mile dual and was timed in 4:14, a meet and UCLA school record. Montgomery challenged strongly with 220 to go but Carter held on grimly and finished a strong two yards in front. Lap times were 62, 2:06.5, 3:11.3.

SC's Ernie Amador and Bill Taylor edged Bruin Bob Carne in a 1:54.5 half-mile as each man ran his all-time fastest and the trio came to the last turn tightly grouped. Carne, in third, was timed in 1:55.

Third Fastest

Little Bobby Hunt, UCLA junior, turned in the nation's third fastest collegiate two-mile, 9:18.7, and ran away from SC's Fernando Ledesma with a killing 64-second last lap, which left the Trojan far down the track. Hunt's prep record shows a fifth-place finish in the Western League mile for University High. His time yesterday is a Bruin record.

Jon Arnett turned in a spar-

kler for SC in the broad jump at 24ft. $\frac{3}{4}$ in., first time over 24ft.

Wilger Wins Pair

Des Koch and Doug Maijala stayed out of the javelin, Jim Lea skipped the 440 and Howard Bugbee the sprints for SC. Rod Wilger took both the 220 and 440, 21.5 and 48.5.

UCLA's Bob Seaman and Don Vick were the expected stars of the yearling meet.

Vick's 54ft. $\frac{1}{2}$ in. shot-put fractured meet, UCLA and national frosh records and he also bettered the meet discus record.

Seaman Wins

Seaman loafed to a 4:21.7 mile win and had an impressive 1:53.4 half mile (meet record). He also had a 49 flat relay lap for the victorious Brubabes whose time, 4:20.1, equaled SC's varsity victory and was a meet record.

Ex-Trojan Jack Davis ran a 14.1 exhibition high hurdle flight.
