

Day Snares Mile, Troy Takes Meet

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Both teams "won" as USC and UCLA staged their 32nd dual track meet at the Coliseum Saturday afternoon before 1,228 in-the-flesh fans, plus TV viewers.

The Trojans remained undefeated in this traditional series, but the Bruins achieved an upset by holding the National Collegiate champions under 100 points. The final reckoning was 89-56.

The companion frosh meet went to the Brubabes, 74-71.

Long awaited was the mile race between UCLA's Bob Day and USC's Bruce Bess, but it turned out to be strictly no contest.

Day Pulls Away

The two sophomores ran head-to-head for two laps, but when Day rounded the track in 60 seconds the third time, it was all over.

Day, whose fastest clocking this year is 4:01.8, set a meet record of 4:04.1. Bess didn't come near his personal best of 4:03.2, being forced to settle for 4:11.7. Incidentally, it was the only varsity mark of the meet.

The Bruins managed to bag five firsts against the injury-ridden Trojans, including a disqualification "gift" in the 440 relay. Ducky Drake's proteges also won the mile, 880, high jump and mile relay.

Most exciting finish of the day occurred in the 880 when Dennis Breckow barely outlasted Chris Johnson as both were timed in 1:52.9.

Swept Three

Except for the two baton races, Vern Wolfe's undefeated squad tallied at least three points in every event and swept the shot, long jump and vault. Theo Viltz captured both hurdles and Dave Morris both sprints for Troy.

Viltz, by the way, had participated in USC's spring football practice Saturday

morning as did several of the other Trojan contestants.

Mahoney Samuels, Wellesley Clayton, Lew Hoyt and Dick Cortese—the latter a last minute scratch from the dashes and relays because of a sinus infection—didn't participate for Troy.

Stuart Recovers

But Larry Stuart, announced as definitely out, entered the javelin throw and won it.

With only the triple jump remaining, the freshman score was 68-68. Steve Workman then came through to win with a leap of 44-ft. 3/4-in., an all-time Brubabe record.
